 Compliance with Covid-19 Related Directives and Guidelines: The Federal Government of Nigeria, State Government, Health Authorities and Regulatory Agencies have issued a number of guidelines and directives aimed at curbing the spread of COVID-19 in Nigeria. Additionally, the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) issued Guidelines on Holding AGM of Public Companies by Proxy. The convening and conduct of the AGM shall be done in compliance with these directives and guidelines.

- Proxy: Any member of the Company entitled to attend and vote at this meeting is also entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote in his/her stead. A proxy need not be a member of the Company. For the appointment of the proxy to be valid, a Proxy Form must be completed and deposited at the office of the Company's Registrar, Cordros Registrars, 70 Norman Willaims Street Ikoyi Lagos not later than 48 hours before the time fixed for the meeting.
