 - (c) That the New Ordinary Shares to be received by Shareholders shall be determined by their cash dividend entitlements divided by a Reference Share Price, which Reference Share Price shall be the ten-day average (starting on June 2, 2022) of the Company's closing share price on the floor of Nigerian Exchange Limited;
 - (d) That the Directors be, and are hereby, authorised to allot to shareholders who elect to receive ordinary shares in the Company in lieu of cash dividends, such number of New Ordinary Shares as shall be determined by the Directors in the manner aforesaid.
 - 10.2 "That upon completion of the process for the payment of dividend (including without limitation, the allotment of the New Ordinary Shares to shareholders who elect to receive same); and in compliance with Section 124 of the Companies and Allied Matters Act No. 3 of 2020 (as amended) and the Companies Regulations 2021, the shareholders hereby approve the cancellation of all of the unissued shares of the Company and authorise the Directors to take all such lawful steps as may be required by statute and/or regulations for implementing the cancellation of the Company's unissued shares."

1. COMPLIANCE WITH COVD-19 RELATED DIRECTIVES AND GUIDELINES

ANNEXURE TO NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Item 11(b) on the Agenda for the Annual General Meeting ("**AGM**") of Chemical and Allied Products Plc (the "**Company**") scheduled to hold at Radisson Blu Hotel, 38/40, Isaac John Street, Ikeja, Lagos on Thursday, June 16, 2022 by 10.00am.

- 1. That the Memorandum of Association of the Company be altered:
- (a) By adding the following paragraphs immediately after Memorandum 6(6):

On May 28, 2003, the authorised share capital of the Company was increased to N150,000,000 (One Hundred and Fifty Million Naira) by the creation of 100,000,000 (One Hundred Million) new ordinary shares of 50 kobo each;

On May 19, 2011, the authorised share capital of the Company was increased to N420,000,000 (Four Hundred and Twenty Million Naira) by the creation of 540,000,000 (Five Hundred and Forty Million) new ordinary shares of 50 kobo each;

On June 13, 2017, the authorised share capital of the Company was increased to N750,000,000 (Seven Hundred and Fifty Million Naira) by the creation of 660,000,000 (Six Hundred and Sixty Million) new ordinary shares of 50 kobo each; and

On September 20, 2021 the issued share capital of the Company was increased to 394,129,760 (Three Hundred and Ninety Four Million, One Hundred and Twenty Nine Thousand, Seven Hundred and Sixty) ordinary shares divided into 788,259,520 (Seven Hundred and Eighty Eight Million, Two Hundred and Fifty Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and Twenty) shares of 50 kobo each by the allotment of 88,259,520 (Eighty Eight Million, Two Hundred and Fifty Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and Twenty) ordinary shares of 50 kobo each.

- 2. That the Articles of Association of the Company be altered:
- (a) By deleting Article 2(4) and substituting with the following new Article 2(4): "The "Act" means the Companies and Allied Matters Act No 3, 2020 (as may be amended or repealed from time to time)"
- (b) In furtherance of (a) above, by substituting all references to "Decree" with "Act"
- (c) By deleting Article 2(9) and all references to the defined terms "Nigerian Citizen or Associations"
- (d) By deleting Article 48(b) and renumbering Article 48(a) to Article 48
- (e) By deleting Article 51(b) and substituting it with the following new Article 51(b):
 - "In the case of any other meeting, by a majority in the number of the members having a right to attend and vote at the meeting, being a majority together holding at least 95% in nominal value of the shares giving a right to attend and vote at the meeting"
- (f) By deleting Article 53 and substituting it with the following new Article 53:
 - "All business shall be deemed special that is transacted at an Extraordinary General Meeting, and also all that is transacted at an Annual General Meeting, with the exception of declaring a dividend, the consideration of the accounts, balance sheets, and the reports of the Directors and Auditors, the election of Directors in the place of those retiring and the appointment of, the fixing of the remuneration of, the Auditors and the appointment of members of the audit committee and the disclosure of remuneration of managers of the company which shall be ordinary business"
- (g) By making the following alteration to Article 83: by deleting the number "75" and replacing it with the number "99"
- (h) By deleting Article 98 and substituting it with the following new Article 98:

"The Directors may meet together physically or virtually for the despatch of business, adjourn, and otherwise regulate their meetings as they think fit. Questions arising at any meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes. In the case of an equality of votes, the Chairman may and the secretary on the requisition of the Chairman or of any two Directors shall, at any time summon a meeting of fourteen days' written notice of Director's meeting which notice shall stipulate the date, time, and place of

the meeting and shall list the items to be discussed thereat provided that a meeting may be held on less than fourteen days' notice if all the Directors or their alternates so agree. Notices may (and shall in case of Directors whose last registered address is outside Nigeria) be sent by email"

(i) By deleting Article 125 and substituting with the following new Article 125:

"A printed and or electronic copy of every balance sheet (including every other document required by law to be annexed thereto) which is to be laid before the Company in general meeting, together with a copy of the auditors' report, shall not less than twenty- one days before the date of the meeting be sent to every member, and every holder of debentures of the Company and to every person registered under Article 32 and two copies each of these documents shall be sent to the Stock Exchange and the Securities and Exchange Commission as well as any other regulator required by law. Provided that this Article shall not require a copy of these documents to be sent to any person of whose address the Company is not aware or to more than one of the joint holders of any shares or debentures.

Electronic copy means a method of electronic communication which includes, but is not limited to facsimile, electronic data message (including but not limited to e-mail), bulletin board communications, internet websites, electronic documents, electronic spreadsheet, print portable document file (pdf), hypertext markup language (html) or similar text displayed via a web browser, electronic data interchange (EDI), compact disc, memory stick, flash drive and computer network communications."

(j) By substituting for Article 130, the following new Article 130 and renumbering same to Article 129:

"A notice may be given by the Company to any member either personally, by electronic mail or by sending it by post to him at his last registered address. In the event of the member's last registered address being outside Nigeria such notice shall be sent by electronic mail. Notice may only be sent by electronic mail to any member who has provided the Company with an electronic mail address."

(k) By renumbering Article 136 to Article 135 and adding the following Article 136 immediately after Article 135:

"Share buy-back

The Company may purchase its own shares including redeemable shares provided that the shareholders, shall by special resolution approve the acquisition by the company of the shares it intends to purchase"

(I) By adding the following Article 137 immediately after Article 136

"Virtual Annual General Meetings

The General Meetings of the Company shall be held at such time and place in Nigeria as the directors shall appoint. However, to the extent permitted by applicable law, all or any of the shareholders may participate in a shareholders' meeting by means of a teleconference, videoconference or other electronic/virtual communication means, which allows all those participating in the meeting to hear and speak to one another. Any person so participating shall be counted as present in person at such meeting, shall be counted in a quorum, and shall be entitled to vote."

- 3. By renumbering all the Articles consecutively from 1 to 137 and by making all consequential alterations in cross references.
- 4. The Board of Directors be and is hereby authorized to take such further action and do such further things as may be required to give effect to the above resolutions; and
- 5. The Company Secretary be and is hereby authorised to make any filings at the Corporate Affairs commission as may be necessary for or incidental to giving effect to the above resolutions.
