Event

Nascon Allied Industries Plc ('the Company') reported a revenue growth of 48% year-on-year to N21.26bn in its unaudited Q2 2023 financials. The stellar performance was driven by price increases and higher volumes, particularly in the Northern region. Across its business regions, revenue from the North (72% of revenue) grew by 55% year-on-year. In the same vein, revenue from the West (22% of revenue) and the East (6% of revenue) regions maintained the momentum witnessed in Q1 2023 with revenue growing by 22% and 83% respectively.

Gross margin spiked to 57% in Q2 2023 from 39% in Q2 2022, as the revenue growth for the period outpaced the cost of sales (Q2 2023: N9.26bn; Q2 2022 N8.81bn +5%). Aside from the relatively stable commodity prices, we believe the higher inventory from 2022 limited the need to procure raw materials, thus shielding the company from cost pressures. Consequently, this led to a 116% year-on-year growth in gross profit to N12.01bn. Notably, the gross margin reported is the highest ever recorded by the Group according to our record.

Operating expense (opex) increased significantly in Q2 2023. It grew by 53% year-on-year to N4.78bn, majorly driven by higher distribution-related expenses. We attribute the increases to higher logistics costs due to energy price pressures. In general, rising inflationary pressures resulted in higher operating expenses. Accordingly, operating expense margin expanded by 82 basis points to 27% (Q2 2022: 26%).

Despite the rise in operating expense, effective pricing and cost-effective measures employed drove operating profit by 251% to N6.22bn from N1.78bn in Q2 2022. Consequently, operating profit margin spiked to 29% from 12% in Q2 2022.

A distinguishing feature of Nascon's performance compared to most Fast Consumer Goods Sector (FMCG) companies was its ability to report an insignificant foreign exchange loss of N69,000, unlike most consumer goods sector. This signifies majority of its borrowings were locally funded.

Profit before tax and after tax grew 261% year on year respectively. This marks a very good financial performance in Q2 2023. The profit after tax margin rose to 20% in Q2 2023.

Outlook

Nascon's Q2 2023 financial performance was significantly above what we expected. Although we expected the Company to increase prices, the magnitude of the actual price increase was higher than our expectations. The material decline in the Company's cost margin evidenced this. As a result, we revised our revenue expectation to N84.99bn (previously: N73.95), also we expect FY 2023 net margin to expand to 17.40% from 9.30% in FY 2022.

On the 31st of July 2023, Dangote Sugar, Nascon and Dangote Rice Limited notified the general public of its proposed mergers to "Dangote Foods Plc" as they believe the action will consolidate and solidify the Group market position and ultimately reposition the Group to harness future opportunities in the Food industry. The merger between its subsidiaries will proceed via a scheme of consideration, eleven (11) ordinary shares in Dangote Sugar will be given for every twelve (12) Nascon shares held.

Following the corporate disclosure, the stock has rallied by 88%. However, at the current price, the stock trades at 10.95x to our revised forward earnings per share of N5.58. Based on a blend of the discounted cash flow (DCF), discounted dividend (DDM), enterprise valuation (EV/EBITDA), and residual income (RIM) methodologies, our estimated justified P/E is 6.63x. This implies a fair value of N36.99.

Hence, we project a 40% potential decline on the stock. In combination with a projected 4% dividend yield, we estimate a total return on the stock is -35%. Hence, we recommend a **SELL.**
