... Cost Management and Loan Growth Sustains BUY Recommendation


Event

GT HoldCo's second quarter results marked a sharp reset from last year's exceptional performance. Profit after tax fell by 57% year-on-year to N190.98bn from N448.55bn in Q2 2024, as the Group's non-interest income normalised following the absence of one-off FX and derivative gains that had inflated prior results. With unrealised FX gains down 93% and derivative income erased entirely, the Naira's appreciation turned last year's tailwind into a temporary drag.

Beneath the headline decline lies a different story. The core banking engine continued to strengthen as net interest income rose by 19% year-on-year to N313.88bn from N264.21bn, supported by robust loan growth, disciplined pricing, and a stronger balance sheet structure.

Interest income grew by 23% to N414.97bn from N336.24bn, reflecting higher earnings from loans and advances as well as investment securities, which expanded year-on-year by 22% and 33%, respectively. Income from investment securities continued to account for the largest share of total interest income as the Group deployed funds into higher yielding instruments.

Investment securities and loans to customers rose by 16% and 21% on a year-to-date basis, while up by 24% and 8% year-on-year respectively, leading to a 6% year-on-year and 8% year-to-date 6% growth in earnings interest asset. Overall, average earnings yield grew to 6.68% in H1 2025 from 6.51% in H1 2024.

Interest expense grew by 40% to N101.10bn from N72.02bn, largely due to higher payments on customer deposits which climbed 59% in line with a 16% year-on-year expansion in customer deposits. However, interest expense on other borrowed funds moderated by 28% as the balance sheet value declined to N211.33bn from N310.02bn



at FY 2024, reflecting repayments tied to outstanding cross-currency swaps at an effective rate of 17%. Nevertheless, cost of funds rose to 1.55% from 1.37% in H1 2024.

Loan impairment charges rose to N41.55bn, up 23% year-on-year. Management attributed this to a write-off related to a major oil and gas exposure, in line with the Group's conservative credit risk framework. Although, there is a possibility of write should there be an improvement.

Operating expenses reached N136.01bn from N102.42bn, representing a 33% uplift. Personnel costs rose by 40%, reflecting the full-year impact of salary adjustments implemented across the Group. AMCON levy and other operating expenses grew by 39% and 31% respectively, driven by the Group's expanding balance sheet and increased technology-related investments. With the absence of one-off FX gains, the cost-to-income ratio rose to 31% from 17% in Q2 2024 — though still below the five-year second-quarter average of 46% (excluding 2023).

Profit before tax stood at N300.52bn, a 39% decline year-on-year. The effective tax rate for Q2 2025 was 36%, compared to 9% in Q2 2024, reflecting a reduction in tax-exempt income such as FX transaction gains, dividends, and interest earned on FGN bonds.

Outlook

We revised our FY 2025 profit after tax forecast downward to N947.22bn (FY 2024: N1.02trn) from N1.11trn previously projected in our Q1 2025 report. The adjustment reflects a more conservative outlook for non-interest income, given the moderation in trading and revaluation gains. However, we see ample room for improvement in net interest income, which we project at N1.42trn, supported by effective cost of fund management and sustained growth in earning asset yields.

The Group's capital position has also been strengthened following the public offer, which provides additional liquidity to drive asset expansion. With management guidance pointing to increased loan book growth amid a declining yield environment, we expect earnings momentum to remain resilient.

Consequently, we raised our fair value estimate to N108.05 from N87.70, translating to a justified P/E of 4.22x and P/B of 1.13x. Based on the today's market close price of N93.25, this implies a potential total return of 25%, inclusive of a 9% dividend yield. We project a total dividend of N8.50 for FY 2025, which includes the N1.00 interim dividend already declared. Despite the significant rally in the share price since our last report, we maintain our **BUY** recommendation on the stock.
