Unilever Nigeria Plc ("the Group") delivered an impressive performance in Q2 2025, extending the growth momentum seen since the start of the year. Revenue rose sharply by 62% year-on-year to N51.13 billion (Q2 2024: N31.59 billion), driven by broad-based growth across all product segments. The Foods and Beauty & Wellbeing divisions led the advance, jumping by 65% and 159%, and contributing 61% and 11% to total revenue, respectively. The Personal Care segment also expanded by 37%, accounting for 28% of overall sales.

The strong topline growth was supported be effective pricing strategies, stronger volume performance on the back of increased marketing and promotional strategies. The deliberate boost in marketing and promotional spending reflects management's renewed focus on regaining market share, particularly after a soft Q2 2024, where revenue grew only 27% year on year when compared to other quarters in the same year (Q1 2024: +58%, Q3 2024: +54%, Q4 2024: +105%)

Despite cost of sales inching higher by 38% year-on-year to N27.86 billion (Q2 2024: N20.21 billion), cost margin fell to 53% from 64% in Q2 2024. The decline reflects easing inflationary pressures. As a result, gross margin expanded by 1000bps to 46% from 36%, while gross profit doubled to N23.26 billion (Q2 2024: N11.38 billion).

Operational efficiency strengthened notably, with opex margin moderating to 26% from 32% in Q2 2024, even as marketing and administrative expenses grew by 37%. The growth in expenses reflected intensified brand promotion, higher royalties and service fees paid to Unilever Plc (UK) for technology and trademark licenses, which moved in tandem with revenue growth. This efficiency improvement supported a strong rebound in operating performance, as operating margin rose to 21% from a negative 5% in Q2 2024, resulting in an operating profit of N10.54 billion compared to a loss of N1.66 billion in Q2 2024.

Finance income surged to N3.17 billion (Q2 2024: N207 million), driven by improved treasury yields and higher interest on call deposits. This more than offset the increase in finance costs to N311 million (Q2 2024: N207 million gain). Consequently, profit before tax rose 597% year on year to N13.40 billion from N1.92 billion in Q2 2024.

After accounting for a 440% rise in tax expense, driven by higher deferred tax liabilities as the Group made additional provision for future tax payments. Nevertheless, Unilever posted a net profit of N8.85 billion, a 719% jump from N1.08 billion in Q2 2024.

Outlook

Following our review of the H1 2025 performance, we expect Unilever Nigeria Plc to sustain its growth momentum through the remainder of the year, supported by improved pricing discipline, cost efficiency, and stronger contributions from the Foods and Beauty & Wellbeing segments. We project full-year revenue of N219.96 billion and profit after tax of N41.05 billion.

Incorporating the Q2 2025 results into our valuation model, we revised our fair value estimate upward to N81.58 (previously N50.01). With the stock price at N74.00, this implies a potential upside of 15%. Accordingly, we maintain our **HOLD** recommendation, reflecting our view that the current price already captures much of the Group's earnings and margin improvement.
